4 (a) REPORT ON VARIOUS EXPANSIONS OF THE 5 CORPS.—Not later than one year after the date of the en-6 actment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall submit 7 to the Committees on Armed Services of the Senate and 8 the House of Representatives a report setting forth the 9 following: $\mathbf{2}$

(1) An assessment of the feasibility and advis ability of distance learning programs for the Senior
 Reserve Officers' Training Corps for students at
 educational institutions who reside outside the viable
 range for a cross-town program.

6 (2) An assessment of the feasibility and advis-7 ability of expanding the eligibility of institutions au-8 thorized to maintain a unit of the Senior Reserve 9 Officers' Training Corps to include community col-10 leges.

(b) BRIEFING ON LONG-TERM EFFECTS ON THE
CORPS OF THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN RECENT PROHIBITIONS.—

14 (1) BRIEFING REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 15 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the 16 Secretary of Defense shall brief the congressional 17 defense committees on the effects of the prohibitions 18 in section 8032 of the Department of Defense Ap-19 propriations Act, 2019 (division A of Public Law 20 115–245) on the long-term viability of the Senior 21 Reserve Officers' Training Corps (SROTC).
