A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of the Interior from taking any action to expand the Mid-Continent Limestone Quarry located near Glenwood Springs, Colorado.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Glenwood Hot Springs
5 Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON EXPANSION OF THE MID-CON-**
7 **TINENT LIMESTONE QUARRY.**

8 (a) PROHIBITION.—The Secretary of the Interior
9 shall not process or approve any application for the expan-

1 sion of existing mineral operations located on any mining
2 or mill site claim located under the general mining laws,
3 or for any mineral material sales contract or application
4 under the Act of July 31, 1947 (commonly known as the
5 “Materials Act of 1947”) (61 Stat. 681, chapter 406; 30
6 U.S.C. 601 et seq.) or the Act of July 23, 1955 (commonly
7 known as the “Surface Resources Act of 1955”) (69 Stat.
8 367, chapter 375; 30 U.S.C. 611 et seq.), for limestone
9 on land managed by the Bureau of Land Management
10 that is located in whole or in part within the land de-
11 scribed in subsection (b).

12 (b) LAND DESCRIBED.—The land referred to in sub-
13 section (a) includes the following land located in Garfield
14 County, Colorado:

15 (1) Sec. 4, T. 6 S., R. 89 W., sixth principal
16 meridian.

17 (2) Secs. 25 and 36, T. 5 S., R. 89 W., sixth
18 principal meridian.

19 (3) Secs. 30 and 31, T. 5 S., R. 88 W., sixth
20 principal meridian.
